All Cannings and Villages Neighbourhood First Responders are still here supporting you and your community.

The summer months have been quiet with few callouts. We have unfortunately lost a few members during these months and are now down to four active members covering from Bishop Cannings, All Cannings and Chirton. But we still seem to cover a reasonable amount of duty and area. In the coming months we will start to look for more volunteers – so if you are interested then please call....

Group coverage for on-call duty time averages 40-45% per month. There are now two emergency kits in the community which are shared with the active members.

We are looking for a volunteer fund raiser for the group.

Someone perhaps with some time on their hands, who would like to support our voluntary effort by helping to raise our profile, fund raise, collect donations, source sponsorship and general group support.

The voluntary scheme has <u>proved</u> to be a valuable asset and service in the local community. Our average response time to a critical emergency is approx. 5-8 minutes for selected emergencies. We cover the surrounding area of Bishop Cannings, Etchilhampton, Coate, Horton, Chirton, Marden, Woodborough, Alton Barnes, Stanton and All Cannings

We work along side the Great Western Ambulance Service NHS Trust supporting them and supporting you.
